

Why Mentor?

Did you know? Young people who are at-risk for not completing high school but who have a mentor are 55% more likely to be enrolled in college than those who don't have a mentor, 81% more likely to report participating regularly in sports or extracurricular activities, 78% more likely to volunteer regularly and more than twice as likely to have held a leadership position in a club or sports team.

S/PA had another unique but highly productive year. Despite the lingering influence of COVID, our students got back on track, with full in-person learning. We finished the year with approximately 185 students in the Program and we have 40 seniors prepared to graduate and advance to college.

We're excited to be moving into our 30th year of providing a high-quality high school education and mentoring to lower income students in New Jersey's urban areas. We started S/PA out of a shoebox in a basement in Short Hills. Today, we are a vibrant organization, with a highly professional staff and board using modern marketing, fundraising, governance, and management skills to ensure our future.

As I've done for my 12 years as President, I first thank our mentors. Your role is what personalizes and differentiates the Program. Your guidance, compassion, and willingness to adjust to each school's in-person reentry plan was incredible. To our funders, you once again answered the call of this deserving cause. You gave these lower income high school kids the financial support to weather another difficult year. We were able to continue to supplement financial aid to many students this year because of your deep generosity.

The steady stream of enrichment sessions were particularly popular. And, most importantly, you did all this while still caring for your own families as they navigated through COVID.

As the fall of 2022 approaches, we will welcome 50 new freshmen. On behalf of all involved, I commit to continuing to make a meaningful impact on the next generation of students.


Virtual Operations and Events

Alumni Updates

In 2022, we were so pleased to launch the first of our enrichment series composed entirely of S/PA Graduates. On Thursday, April 28th, a panel of S/PA Graduates from Hudson Catholic, St. Benedict's Prep, Saint Vincent Academy, and Immaculate Conception High School shared what it is really like being in college today.

During the zoom session, the S/PA graduates Kimani Williams, Anthony Augustin, Brianna Mateo, Hervluida Metellus, and Quincy Slay shared tips on making the most out of your college experience, whether that meant networking with professors, getting the most appropriate summer job, or finding the best ways to navigating stress. Smaller break out rooms helped to facilitate a more open dialogue between students, mentors, and the panelists.

Kimani Williams (Immaculate Conception High School 2021 grad), a Biology and Public Health Pre-Med major and Peer Health Educator at Tuskegee University graduated from ICHS in 2020 and joined the panel because "she wanted students to understand the importance of having a balance, and understanding the importance of time-management in college."

Quincy Slay (Hudson Catholic 2019 grad) noted, "The advice that I would like to give to students is to be open minded when going into college. Attending college and trying to pick a major can be very complex but the one thing that you need to remember is that you have the opportunity to explore before you make a final decision. Furthermore, make sure that you want to study the major that you pick because you want to graduate and be happy with the degree you walk across the stage with."

The college students offered suggestions for work/life balance and fielded questions from both mentors in students.

Executive Director Margaret Momber reflected "It was truly amazing to watch these young alumni thrive as panelists on the zoom. I remember seeing these young students as bright-eyed freshmen, and it was incredible to see them thriving as young adults and leaders in their colleges and universities as they gave back to the S/PA community. We are striving to increase alumni connections and these types of enrichment programs are perfect for this type of continued relationship."
